REGULATIONS, ELIGIBILITY & CALENDAR OF EVENTS FOR ADMISSION TO LL.M (2 YEARS) COURSE 2024-25

(I) ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

- a) Candidates seeking admission to LL.M Degree under Semester Scheme should have passed the LL.B degree of the Bangalore University or any other UGC recognized Universities and should have secured 45% in the aggregate of 3year/5year LL.B Degree Examination, (For Karnataka candidates- 5% relaxation for SC/ST, Cat-I applicants whose annual income is not more than Rs. 8 lakhs except Cat-I and for Person with disability).
- b) There shall be a Common Entrance Test (CET) for all the eligible candidates for admission to the course as specified below.
- c) Merit List of the candidates shall be prepared by the admission committee based on the following criteria:
 - 1. 50% of the marks secured by the candidate in the CET and,
 - 2. 50% of the marks obtained in 3/5 year LL.B degree course in the aggregate.
 - 3. No candidate otherwise eligible for admission shall be admitted if he/she fails to attend the CET and the counseling on the notified dates.
 - 4. No student shall be permitted to pursue any other course of study leading to any other degree while he/she is pursuing LL.M course.

(II) INTAKE FOR THE COURSE

The number of candidates to be admitted to the Two Year Post-Graduate Degree Programme in Law (LL.M – Semester Scheme) shall be 10 Regular Seats, 2 Self Finance Seat Payment Seat for Karnataka Candidate category and 2 Payment seats for Non-Karnataka Candidate category, in the following branches of specialization:

- 1. Constitution and Legal Order
- 2. Corporate and Commercial Law
- 3. Criminal Law
- 4. Human Rights and Environmental Law
- 5. Labour and Employment Law

Supernumerary seats shall be allotted only to Karnataka Candidate category except Jammu & Kashmir, Kashmir Migrant & Children of Defence personnel.

(IV) RESERVATION OF SEATS

The admission of the candidates shall be based on merit cum reservation policy of the State Government/Rules of Bangalore University with regard to Supernumerary seats issued from

(i) Rural Candidate

"Rural Candidate" is one who is a "Karnataka Student", "Bangalore University student" and has studied for 10 full academic years from 1st Standard to 10th Standard in educational institution situated in the State of Karnataka other than larger Urban area, smaller Urban area or transitional area as mentioned in Karnataka Municipalities Act, 1964 or Karnataka Municipal Corporation Act, 1976 in accordance with the Government Order No.: ED-01-TEC 2002. Bangalore, dated 01-02-2002 and the eligibility criteria shall be as defined in the Karnataka Reservation of Appointments of Posts in the Civil services of the State for Rural Candidates Act, 2000 (Karnataka Act 1 of 2001). Candidates who have studied TEN full academic years from 1stStandard to 10th Standard in Rural Area (as per Govt. notification) will be eligible for claiming the benefit of rural reservations. However, if the candidates have studied in urban area from 1st to 10th standard before the date of notification as urban area, such candidates are eligible to claim rural reservation benefit.

(ii) Kannada Medium Candidate

Kannada medium candidate is one who is a "Karnataka student" and "Bangalore University student" and has studied TEN full academic years in Kannada medium from 1st Standard to 10th Standard, in accordance with the Government Order No. ED 118 UEC 2000, Bangalore dated 04-06-2000 and as amended vide Government Order No. ED 02 UEC 2002, Bangalore dated 14-10-2005.

NSS quota (iii)

Candidate claiming seat under NSS quota is one who is a "Karnataka student" and "Bangalore University student" and has completed two year under NSS by attending at least one College camp during the degree course in Bangalore University (the achievements during ten plus two or of other Universities will not be considered).

(iv) NCC quota

Candidate claiming seat under NCC quota is one who is a "Karnataka student" and "Bangalore University student" and possess minimum NCC "C" Certificate.

(v)Cultural quota

Candidate claiming seat under Cultural quota is one who is a "Karnataka student" and "Bangalore University student" and who has participated in at least one item in Inter College Competitions organized by Bangalore University.

(vi) Sports quota

Candidate claiming seat under Sport quota is one who is a "Karnataka student" and "Bangalore University student" and participated in the specified sports -UG level.

(vii) Defence quota

Candidate claiming seat under defence quota is one whose either of the parents serving/served in the defence forces of Government of India

(viii) Kashmiri Migrant quota

Candidate claiming seat under "Kashmiri Migrant" is one as defined by the Government of India.

(ix) Jammu & Kashmir students-

Candidates claiming seats under said quota is who belongs to Jammu & Kashmir Region.

(x) Hyderabad Karnataka.

Candidate claiming seat under Hyderabad Karnataka is one who belongs to Hyderabad Karnataka Region as designed specified in the relevant Govt. Order.

(xi) Transgender

Respective Candidate claiming seat under the said quota.

(xii) Single Girl Child

Bangalore University candidate claiming seat under the quota is one who is a single girl child to the Parents.

(xiii) Foreign National quota

Candidate claiming seat under Foreign National quota is one who is not a Citizen of India. Preference is given to candidates who are sponsored by the Government of India/ICCR.A foreign student from other than English speaking countries seeking admission to Two Year Post Graduate Degree Programme in Law (LL.M-Semester Scheme) shall have completed the TOEFEL or other equivalent exam from fulfilling the minimum eligibility conditions. However, he/she shall be exempted from the admission test.

(xiv) Bangalore University Employee Quota

One seat each is reserved for children of Teaching and Non-teaching staff of Bangalore University.

(xv) Persons with Disabilities quota

"Persons with disabilities" candidate is one who is a "Karnataka student" and "Bangalore University student" and shall have the same meaning as assigned for the Persons with disabilities as given under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016.

(xvi) Karnataka Candidate category:

Applicant/Candidates who has studied in one or more Government or Government recognized Educational institutions or Universities located in the State of Karnataka for a minimum period of seven academic years commencing from 1st standard up to qualifying examination either continuously or in broken period and acquired qualifying graduation from any recognised university.

(xxi) Non-Karnataka Candidate category: All candidates who do not fulfil the requirements as mentioned at (IV) (xvi) are Non Karnataka Candidates.

(V) HOW TO APPLY

- a) Candidates eligible as per eligibility requirements may fill in application forms online on www.bangaloreuniversity.karnataka.gov.in or www.ulcbangalore.com
- b) Duly filled in applications along with self-attested relevant testimonials/documents in all respects must reach the Office of the Principal and Chairman, University Law College & Dept. of studies in Law, Bangalore University, Jnana Bharathi Campus, Bengaluru-560 056, either in person or by post on or before the last date of submission.
- c) Entrance test question will be based on multiple choice questions for 50 marks.
