**Out of 15 GM (Regular) seats, 13 seats for GM, 01 seat -GM-HK, 01 seat -GM-PWD shall be filled by merit - cum- branch option of the candidate. If HK/PWD candidates are not available, those seats shall remain within pool of GM category.

***Out of 15 reserved seats, 01 seat -HK & 01 seat-PWD shall be allotted to candidates based on merit cum branch option irrespective of category. In case of non-availability of HK & PWD applicants, those seats shall remain within pool of reserved category.

3. Karnataka State Law University (KSLU) was established in the year 2009, and all the Law Colleges of the State was affiliated to KSLU. University Law College, BUB being a constituent College of Bangalore University and LL.M. being a Professional course, (1) Karnataka candidate category and (2) non-Karnataka candidate category seats shall be treated and allotted as stated below:

(a) Karnataka candidates category:

Applicant/Candidates who has studied in one or more Government or Government recognized educational institutions for a minimum period of seven academic years commencing from 1st to 12th standard either continuously or in broken period and passed the qualifying examination in Karnataka.

(b) Non-Karnataka Candidate category: All Candidates who do not fulfill the requirements as above (a) are Non-Karnataka Candidates.

Supernumerary seats shall be allotted only to **Karnataka Candidates category** except Jammu & Kashmir, Kashmiri Migrant and Children of Defence Personnel. Further these seats shall not exceed 5 numbers in each branch (excluding Foreign Nationals). If no applications are received under the supernumerary quota, the vacant seats shall not be transferred to other quota and shall freeze.

(5) PROCEDURE FOR FILLING THE VACANT SEATS IN DIFFERENT RESERVED CATEGORIES

(A) Regular seat/Payment seat- Karnataka Candidates category - Unfilled Reserved Category seats shall be transferred as mentioned below:

If any seat falls vacant due to non-availability of applications, lack of any other eligible candidates in different categories such as SC, ST, CAT-I, IIA, IIB, IIIA, IIIB, shall be filled up by taking the candidates from the next category in the sequential order:

Illustration:

(i) If SC or ST seats are vacant

SC seat to ST category	}	If no candidates are available in SC/ST category , only then the seats shall be transferred to Cat-1,
ST seat to SC category		

(ii) If Category I seats are vacant, those seats shall be transferred by allotting each seat to the next category in sequential order i.e., Category 2A, 2B, 3A, 3B, SC, ST, GM respectively.

(iii) If 2A category seats are vacant, those seats shall be transferred by allotting each seat to the next category in sequential order i.e., Category 2B, 3A, 3B, SC, ST, Cat-1, GM respectively.

(iv) If 3A category seats are vacant, those seats shall be transferred by allotting each seat to the next category in sequential order i.e., Category 3B, SC, ST, Cat-1, 2A, 2B, GM respectively.
