The Annual/Semester fees under Regular and Payment categories prescribed for LL.M Two years Courses, offered in **University Law College** for candidates seeking admission to LL.M courses during the Academic year 2024-25 are notified as under.

(2) PAYMENT SEAT FEES

The GM/OBC/Minorities candidates seeking admission under Payment Category shall pay the following fees (Shown in Column 3) in addition to the regular fees. Since fees paid under payment seats is not reimbursable from the Govt SC/ST/Cat-I candidates whose parents annual income is less than 2.5 Lakhs are required to pay the fee (Shown in Column 4) in addition to Regular fees and SC/ST/Cat-I candidates whose parents' annual income is more than 2.5 Lakhs shall pay the fees as in Column 3 in addition to Regular fee.

Note: The fees concession is not applicable to SC/ST/Cat-I students of outside Karnataka.

(3) ELIGIBILITY FEES

Indian Nationals who have passed the qualifying examination outside Karnataka shall pay the following **Eligibility Fees** to the University at the time of counseling in addition to the regular fees.

Indian Nationals, Foreign Nationals and Non Resident Indians who have passed the qualifying examination abroad (outside India) shall submit the Equivalence Certificate issued by Association of Indian Universities (AIU) along with the application to the University. The provisional Eligibility certificate will be issued on payment of the prescribed fee. The provisional Eligibility certificate shall be obtained prior to admission.

(4) FEES PRESCRIBED FOR FOREIGN NATIONALS & NRIs

The Foreign Nationals and NRIs shall pay US \$ 2,200 as annual fees in addition to Eligibility fees for various courses.

(5) Mode of Payment : Students selected has to pay the admission fee **ONLINE THROUGH** Bangalore University website <https://bangaloreuniversity.karnataka.gov.in>

(6) FEES CONCESSION AND REIMBURSEMENT FOR SC/ST CANDIDATES:

The SC/ST candidates within Karnataka and whose parents annual income is less than 2,50,000/- (Rupees Two Lakh Fifty Thousand Only) per annum shall pay Rs.500/- (Rupees Five Hundred Only) for regular seats and Rs. 500/- plus payment Seats for payment seats category.

The Principal shall direct the SC/ST students to pay the balance of Admission fee received from the Social Welfare Department, Government of Karnataka, i.e., fess due to be paid at the time of admission prior to payment of even semester examination fee. In case of non-receipt of Fees reimbursement for what so-ever reasons mentioned therein/short payment of fee reimbursement by the Social Welfare Department, such students shall also be directed to pay the balance of admission fees in full (which was due to b paid at the time of admission) prior to payment of even semester examination fee. The original marks cards submitted by the student at the time of admission and other documents if any (I semester II semester, TC) shall not be issued until the students clear all the dues.

The Fees Reimbursement is not applicable to SC/ST students of other states.

(7) REFUND AND FORFEITURE OF FEES

(1) Candidate for any reason may cancel his/her seat by submitting the following documents;

- i) Original Provisional Admission Card
- ii) Original Fee Receipt
- iii) Application for cancellation of seat and refund of fee paid with clear & complete correspondence address with Bank details

and

(2) Refund shall be considered as per clause 4.1.3 of the UGC Fee Refund Policy 2023-24 vide D.O. No.F.2-71/2022(CPP-II) dated: 3rd July 2023, the following tier system for the refund of fees* remitted by the student shall be followed:

Sl. No.	Percentage of Refund of fees*	Point of time when notice of withdrawal of admission is received in the University
(1)	80%	15 days or less after the formally-notified last date of admission.
(2)	50%	30 days or less, but more than 15 days, after formally-notified last date of admission.
(3)	00%	More than 30 days after formally-notified last date of admission.




